

# Our History

Tempus fugit: time flies - for all of us. Sooner or later we will all need the help of a funeral director, and although there may be new businesses which can provide such services, for some it never seems quite right, or respectful, to make use of a firm that has not acquired the elusive patina of age, that indefinable degree of dignity which can only be gained through having been around for many years.

A.W. Lymn The Family Funeral Service is a well known name and has long been associated with Nottingham's inner city. Our headquarters is still located in Sneinton just a few hundred yards from Goosegate, where our founders, Arthur William Lymn and his son Harold Percy Lymn, traded as furniture makers and dealers at the turn of the nineteenth century.

In 1907 father and son decided to specialise in the manufacture and supply of coffins and the provision of a full funeral service, hence their entry into the 'undertaking' profession as it was most commonly known in those days.

The new business was soon so successful that it had to move to larger premises. In 1915 the office was moved to Bath Street, opposite Sneinton Market. The firm's horses were stabled in Robin Hood Street and coffins manufactured in Handel Street. The stables were eventually replaced with garaging for motor vehicles; the same site now housing the impressive Rolls-Royce fleet, reputed to be the largest privately owned fleet of such vehicles in the world.

When Arthur William Lymn died in 1929 control of the business passed to his widow Louisa and their son Harold. When Louisa in turn passed on in 1939 Harold took sole charge. Despite the coming of war in 1939, the introduction of petrol rationing and other wartime restrictions the business still continued to grow. Harold himself was involved in the war effort serving as a volunteer at the Civil Defence mortuary.

Harold's son Douglas and son-in-law George Rose continued to develop the business which became a limited company in 1958. Douglas and George became members of the British Institute of Embalmers and were involved in the first repatriation of human remains from England to Pakistan at about this time.

In 1977, a year after Harold's death, the company moved its headquarters to Robin Hood House, in Robin Hood Street where the main hub of the firm can still be found today.

Sheila Lymn Rose (Harold's daughter) although fully retired still likes to hear how the family business is progressing. Her son Nigel, daughter-in-law Penny and daughter Jackie are still actively involved as Chairman and Directors. The business is now largely run by Sheila's grandchildren, the fifth generation with Matthew as Managing Director, Chlöe a Director and Ben and his wife Emma looking after Marketing and PR. The importance of having the right management to take the business forward is fully appreciated and to this end Pete Clarson has been appointed as Commercial Director and as such is the first independent member of the board who is not a member of the founder's family.

Over the decades the firm has expanded greatly, and we now have 27 funeral homes serving the whole of Nottinghamshire and South Derbyshire, as well as an in-house floristry division. Our fleet is renowned across the country and regularly travels great distances to be of service.

The company is a member of the National Association of Funeral Directors, of which Nigel was the President during its Centenary year in 2005, and boasts more holders of the association's Diploma in Funeral Directing than any other private funeral business within the country. The company is also a member by invitation of the prestigious European Group of Selected Independent Funeral Homes and Matthew was installed as Chair of this organisation in 2022.

In line with the founders' aspiration the business still strives for perfection of service ahead of maximisation of profit. It therefore re-invests heavily in its staff and ploughs much of the profits back into its fleet, premises and facilities provided for the benefit of the bereaved families that it serves.















# The Family Funeral Service®

In August 1907 Arthur William Lymn conducted his first funeral and the undertakers originally trading as A.W. Lymn and now known as A.W. Lymn The Family Funeral Service was formed. Since then the business has continued to maintain the founder's vision of placing the emphasis on quality of service, value for money and the meeting of clients' needs.

As a result we now have an excellent reputation, employ highly qualified and experienced staff and are readily accessible through our network of local offices serving Nottinghamshire and South Derbyshire. We feel that our long history and association with the local community give the families we serve the benefit of our expert knowledge and detailed history that is not readily available elsewhere.

We believe that client choice is paramount to providing good service. To this end we have extensive information on local churches, ministers, cemeteries and crematoria and further have access to a range of unique supplies and services many of which are detailed in this brochure. In the 55 years I have been involved, the skills required to run a family business have increased enormously and as such we have had to look outside the family for qualified and talented personnel to join us.

I am very pleased that the business is still wholly owned by the founders' family. The fourth generation represented by my

Every funeral arranged by A.W. Lymn The Family Funeral Service will have a written estimate prepared in advance by an experienced funeral arranger. This will need to be signed along with our contract by our client being the person making the decisions and ultimately responsible for paying the invoice. As part of this process a discussion will take place concerning the funding of the funeral. Unlike many funeral directors we do not generally insist on a payment before the day of the funeral. However, some cemeteries require payment in advance.

The final invoice will be sent approximately one week after the funeral. In the event of the funeral being substantially funded by a pre-paid funeral plan the invoice for any items ordered but not paid for by the plan provider will also be sent to our client at this time.

### Invoices to Third Parties

When requested we will send an invoice directly to a third party such as another family member, bank, building society, solicitor or insurance company for payment, and prepare a duplicate copy for information purposes and send this to our client. The client instructing A.W. Lymn The Family Funeral Service and signing the contract will remain ultimately responsible for payment and interest is payable if a long delay occurs before payment is received. ## Other Help Available

Some clients will be eligible for help with funeral costs from the DWP. Our funeral arrangers will be able to advise clients on their eligibility for such claims. The maximum DWP Funeral Expenses Payment will never cover the full cost of a funeral. We have expert staff available to help with DWP claims and to assist in obtaining any further help available from government or charities.

### Discounts & Affinities

### Traditional Funeral Service

Most clients visualise a traditional funeral as including the transfer of the deceased from the place of death, professional fees, preparation of the deceased, use of a Chapel of Rest, a hearse, a following car, cortège via local address, provision of bearers, service in the crematorium chapel and returning the mourners' home.

# Third Party Costs

As well as the charges made by the funeral director, third party suppliers provide essential parts of the funeral service such as burial or cremation charges, the supply of a celebrant to lead the service, medical certificates, flowers and catering. A typical example of these costs is shown below however it must be remembered that these vary on every occasion and will normally be more expensive in the case of burial.

Crematorium fee: . . . . . . These can vary from £575.00 - £1,115.00 depending on various factors

The Church of England agreed fee is £228.00, the A.W. Lymn Celebrant's fee is £270.00 (including transport)

Cremation form No.4 is £82.00 plus mileage

We offer a facility of loans to our clients subject to an affordability survey through a simple system and set loan amounts. The main points are:-

- No need for loan security
- No early repayment penalty
- Loans are available from £600.00 £3,000.00.
- Interest is payable at rates ranging from 14.8% 16.9% APR

The loan agreement is made at the discretion of the lender, who reserves the right to withdraw loan offers at any time prior to an agreement being signed by both parties. Additional interest and charges will apply if the loan is not repaid in line with the terms of the agreement. Any costs incurred by the lender, as a result of the borrower defaulting on the loan repayments, will also be added to the loan balance. #### Funeral With No Mourners

A very simple service at a location selected by the family, at a disclosed date and time, with the Funeral Director saying a poem or prayer as requested and taking a photograph of the coffin.

#### The Funeral With No Mourners Package includes the following:

Transfer of the deceased from the place of death (up to 100 running miles) at any time. Administration of paperwork. Attending to the necessary arrangements during office hours at our premises. Care of the deceased person prior to the funeral including dignified presentation. Provision of a hearse (which may be closed) direct to the funeral. Provision of the necessary staff to transport the coffin using a wheeled bier. Provision of a coffin (which may be cardboard). Collection of cremated remains from the crematorium and returning to our office in a CR00 scatter tube.

# Assistance With Paperwork

When a family wish to deal with all aspects of the funeral arrangements themselves and we are simply required to assist with the legal paperwork and general advice we are willing to do so within office hours at our premises.

### Total A.W. Lymn The Family Funeral Service Assistance with Paperwork Package £450.0

When required, we will bring the deceased into our care from the place of death (up to 100 running miles) and hold them for up to a calender month for an additional £500.00.

We can also supply a Rolls-Royce Phantom VII hearse for up to two hours for an extra £900.00.

This package is only available if the full account is paid at the time of completing the paperwork.



### Financial Advice

Dealing with money matters is often the last thing you want to be doing when you have suffered a bereavement. Unfortunately, it is something that has to be addressed and some financial matters are more pressing than others. Time delays can lead to unnecessary complication and cost.

#### What should be done first?

The first thing is to register the death and take care of the funeral arrangements.

The cost of the funeral can normally be released directly from one of the deceased's accounts upon production of the invoice and death certificate, if there are sufficient funds. If there are insufficient funds, the client may be eligible to help from the State - please ask and you will be advised of the eligibility criteria.

It is advisable to write a list with the following information about the deceased:-

- Accounts/Shares/ISA's etc
- Life Insurance
- Private Pensions/Annuities
- DWP/State Pension
- Utility Companies
- Council Tax
- Buildings Insurance

All these people may have to be contacted and creating a list at the start will help organise what needs to be done.

The person that has the responsibility of dealing with the administration of the estate is either:

- The executor if there is a Will
- The next of kin under the rules of Intestacy if there is no Will

It will be up to them to decide whether they wish to deal with matters personally or whether to get assistance from a solicitor with the administration of the estate.

The circumstances will dictate, and it is often not required on the first death in a couple whose assets are held jointly.

Some solicitors offer a free initial consultation to assess whether you require their services, you may wish to take advantage of this. If not and you require assistance later after coming up against something you are finding it difficult to deal with - go and get their help rather than worrying.

# Registration of Death

One part of the 'funeral process' that your funeral director will not be able to do for you is to register the death. This needs to be completed by the legally responsible person, normally a relative, executor, someone present at the death, the occupier of the premises where the death occurred, or the person arranging the funeral.

This person must speak to the registrar once the Medical Certificate of Cause of Death (MCCD) has been issued by the doctor and emailed to appropriate Register Office. Our staff will be more than happy to advise you whether you need to attend the register office where you must go to do this or if the registrar will contact you by telephone, to make the appointment.

When you register a death we recommend that you take advantage of the "Tell Us Once" scheme, where you will be able to tell the government authorities just once about your change of circumstances. A death normally needs to be registered within five days, unless the Coroner is investigating the circumstances. In certain situations the five day period can be extended.

#### The Registrar will interview you in private to gather the following information for the register:

- The date and place of death
- The person's full name at time of death
- Any names previously used, including maiden surname
- The person's date and place of birth (town and county if born in the UK and country only if born abroad)
- Their last address
- Their occupation
- The full name, date of birth and occupation of a deceased or surviving spouse or civil partner
- Whether they were receiving a state pension or any other state benefit

The Registrar will record all details in draft form and will ask you to check that they have been recorded correctly. The non-statistical information will then be copied into the register book, which you will be asked to check through carefully and sign.

The registrar will also offer you access to the "Tell Us Once" service.

- Housing Benefit
- Library services
- Passport Service
- War Pensions scheme

- Attendance Allowance

- Driver & Vehicle Licensing Agency
- Income Support
- Overseas Health Team
- Personal taxation
- Working Tax Credit

- Blue Badge parking permit
- Children's services
- Council Tax Benefit
- Employment Support Allowance
- Jobseeker's Allowance
- Owed payments to the Council
- Tax help for older people

Where applicable, "Tell Us Once" will pass details to these departments on your behalf. The departments you choose to notify will contact you directly if they need any more information to process your change in circumstances.

#### On completion the Registrar will issue:

- A certificate for burial or cremation 'green form' which enables the funeral to proceed (however, if the Coroner is involved different procedures may apply). This is issued free of charge.
- A BD8 Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) form for pension or benefit purposes. This is also issued free of charge.
- You may also purchase certified copies of the entry (death certificates) at a cost of £11.00.
- A card for you to complete if you wish for the deceased's details to be removed from mailing lists, however we will complete this on your behalf.


# Certification

At A.W. Lymn The Family Funeral Service we have experienced local staff on call at all times, day or night, to answer the telephone personally. They can arrange the transfer of the deceased from the place of death, make contact with a qualified funeral director to give immediate and detailed advice or simply help and guide you through that difficult and no doubt unfamiliar period immediately following a death.

Our advice to all families is that when a death occurs they contact us immediately. In many cases now when people pass away in hospital, it is not necessary for us to attend immediately, however our staff can give the helpful advice needed to put people's minds at ease, and to ensure that the family is aware of everything which is needed to be done. On pages 94 - 95 of this brochure are all area office numbers. Our telephones are answered by by local experienced funeral arrangers at all times day and night.

# Transportation and Care of the Deceased

£500.00

The provision of up to two staff at any time day or night to move the deceased from any address to our premises, or to another location as requested by H.M. Coroner, and then to our premises at a later date up to a maximum of 100 running miles. The price includes the use of a suitable vehicle, all necessary protective clothing for the staff, a Ferno-Washington American Ambulance-type stretcher and cover, disposable sheets and identity bracelets as required. Also holding the deceased in a cold room facility for up to a month and as and when required, staff to assist with the examination by doctors.

Excess mileage on the collection of the deceased will be charged at £1.00 per mile travelled in excess of 100 miles.

Plus ferry and toll charges and when an overnight stay is necessary subsistence and hotel charges.

Receptions £250.00

Reception in to Church or delivery to another address prior to the funeral, including the provision of a Rolls-Royce Phantom VII hearse finished in silver, conductor and bearers from 9am to 6pm Monday to Friday excluding bank holidays. At all other times.

# Out of Hours Service Surcharge

£500.00

Additional cost for a funeral on a Sunday, Bank holiday or out of normal working hours.

# Multiple Funeral Surcharge

- · Liaising with celebrant, cemetery, crematorium, church, organist, verger etc. for arranging the timing and details of the funeral
- Formally confirming funeral details to the family and to the celebrant
- Wording and placing announcements in local or national newspapers and online
- Designing, compiling, proof checking, collecting and delivering service sheets
- Dealing with all enquiries relating to the funeral
- All necessary telephone and postage charges
- Making available documents relating to other matters such as bereavement services
- Provision of a pack of documents including a written confirmation and estimate
- Use of the company premises for the reception and return of mourners before and after the funeral
- Receiving and listing of floral tributes
- Provision of a conductor to deal with mourners, administer the funeral, and provide guidance and control during the funeral ceremony
- The use of a wheelchair, various flags, music, iPod and sound system etc
- Receiving, handling, acknowledging and forwarding donations
- Distribution of flowers to one address within a 10 mile radius of the place of service or our funeral home





# Cortège Driving

On request, we will supply enough cortège driving hangers for the drivers of any private cars to assist them in keeping together on the journey and parking at the place of ceremony. If more are required please ask your funeral director who will also have them available on the day of the funeral.

# Carrying of Coffins & Caskets

It is company policy, wherever practicable and appropriate, to carry the coffin at shoulder height. However, certain conditions may prevent this. A risk assessment will be made on each occasion, and your funeral arranger should advise the client, before the funeral, if extra staff may be required and the additional costs thereof, or if shoulder carrying is not a viable option.

### Music

At most local crematoria a system is available to download music from the internet to use during the service. We have contact with several soloists, bands, choirs and musicians who can be engaged when required, we also have iPods and sound systems available for use.

# Personal Address Systems, Video Screens & Recording of Services

Through relationships with local firms we are able to offer PA systems to allow a service to be broadcast to a large congregation, video links to extend the service to another venue, and recording equipment to allow a video or audio recording of a service to be made and kept by the family.

# Webcasting

Sending live video through the internet allows bereaved relatives and friends to share the funeral ceremony when they are unable to attend in person. We have found that the service is particularly valued by those who live abroad and also those who would like to be present at a funeral but are not fit to travel.

# Catering

If catering is required after the funeral the client can either make their own arrangements or contact us to make a booking at a hotel or provide catering and/or staff at our premises or at a family members home.

Ushers per person £50.00

This practice includes an usher from A.W. Lymn The Family Funeral Service attending in advance to welcome all of the mourners, show them to their seats in advance whenever possible and hand out printed orders of service if these have been provided. The usher will also hand out listing of mourners cards as explained below if required. This service is included in our Professional Fee for funerals at multiple locations.

Listing Mourners £25.00\*

This practice means a listing of mourner's card is either placed inside the printed orders of service if these have been provided or left at the service venue. At the end of the service the cards will be collected by our funeral staff. We produce a list of all the mourner's names alphabetically, together with those names of people who could not attend but were represented. Multiple copies can be produced if required, and there is the option of submitting the details online if mourners prefer.







A civil funeral celebrant's role is to lead a funeral or celebration of life and to introduce others such as family or friends who may wish to take part.

What is said and shared during a civil funeral or memorial ceremony is decided by family and friends with the guidance and support of the civil funeral celebrant.

In addition to a network of trusted independent civil celebrants, A.W. Lymn The Family Funeral Service employs three celebrants, all of whom hold the NOCN Level 3 Diploma in Funeral Celebrancy and the National Association of Funeral Directors' Diploma in Funeral Directing.

### Choosing the right officiant

A Religious Minister: They will deliver a full liturgy relevant to their religion including sacred text or scriptural readings, prayers, blessings, hymns or sacred songs and will commit the soul of the person who has died to God's safekeeping. Many families may already have a connection to a place of worship and will have contact with a priest, pastor, rabbi, imam, pandit or other minister of religion. We can help if you do not know the minister or have a connection with the place of worship

Each religion and religious denomination should happily provide further information on the type of funerals they are willing to provide before you make any decision or commitment.

An Independent or Civil Celebrant: According to The Institute of Civil Celebrants "A Civil Funeral is driven by the wishes, beliefs and values of the deceased and their family, not by the beliefs or ideology of the person conducting the funeral. It sits between a religious and a humanist funeral"

In other words Celebrants are happy to include religious content, such as a hymn or The Lord's Prayer, without the funeral being a fully religious ceremony. They are equally happy to lead an entirely non-religious funeral. They are usually trained and accredited by a professional body such as the IOCF, AIC or similar

A Humanist Celebrant: Humanists do not believe in any form of afterlife or spiritual existence, angels or the existence of any God or gods. They view death as a part of life and rely on science for answers about the world. Their ceremonies have no religious or spiritual content whatsoever. However, they do emphasise empathy and compassion for others and celebrating the life and achievements of the person who has died. A Humanist Celebrant will be trained and accredited by Humanists UK, formerly The British Humanist Association.

All funeral ceremonies should be personal and relevant to the individual who has died. Do be aware that different types of service or ceremony may offer greater or lesser opportunity for input regarding choice of music, poetry, personal reminiscences, life story and so on. It is always wise to check with the officiant that they are willing to provide exactly the type of ceremony that the family want and is appropriate for the person who has died.

#### The Sustainable Funeral

In 2023 we undertook market research and found that nearly three quarters of those surveyed in Nottingham say a sustainable funeral is important to them.

As a company that recognises that the needs of the communities we support change over time, we have acted on this research and purchased our first electric vehicles.

Below are some ways in which you can make a funeral more sustainable:

- Choose a natural burial. There are many sites in the local area including Tithe Green Natural Burial (Oxton), The Vale of Belvoir Natural Burial Ground (Bottesford), Prestwold Natural Burial Ground (Prestwold) and Dale Hill Natural Burials (Ockbrook).
- Although cremation is generally regarded as less environmentally friendly the newly opened Rushcliffe Oaks in Stragglethorpe is an environmentally conscious facility using renewable energy sources and is one of the first in the country to invest in innovative all-electric technologies.
- When purchasing a coffin, have a look at what they are made from and if any 'airmiles' have been involved in getting them to the UK. We have a large range of coffins and caskets made from natural British materials such as wool (bottom of page 45) and Musgrove wicker (page 44).
- We now have an electric fleet of vehicles including a Ford Mustang Mach-E hearse and matching cars (page 32), as well as a closed hearse Mercedes eVito (page 35).
- Traditional funeral flowers are almost always created in plastic floral foam. More sustainable floral design alternatives such as a hand-tied sheaf or an eco-friendly base are available. Please speak to our florist to discuss options.
- Balloons have been used for many years as a visual expression of love for the one who has passed, as an alternative consider our doves which are looked after at the Lymn Rose family home. Please note that some venues have restrictions on bird releases. Your funeral arranger will be able to advise you on this.
- Create a lasting tribute to a loved one by dedicating a 'Memory Leaf' with our partners at Nottinghamshire Wildlife Trust. These beautiful brass leaves can be installed at Nature Reserves across Nottinghamshire, providing a tranquil space for you to visit. All gifts in memory go directly to supporting the Trust's work protecting wildlife, preserving these precious wild spaces for future generations.











In 2007 to mark 100 years of service to the families of Nottinghamshire and South Derbyshire the company created a charitable foundation to thank those communities for their continued commitment to its success. A.W. Lymn The Family Funeral Service made a substantial financial commitment to launch the Centenary Foundation and has continued each year to donate at least £10.00 to the trust for every private funeral that it undertakes.

The Foundation has five Trustees, two of which are totally independent of the company, two of which are non-family members of staff and one is a Director of the Company. It is administered by Ben J. Percival, great-great-grandson of the Company's founder Arthur William Lymn.

The essence of the relationship is that the company finances the trust and the Trustees then decide how to distribute the assets of the trust to local good causes. The idea is to distribute the monies back to the communities which the company serves.

Applications for funding can be made by any local person, group, committee or organisation. These should be made in writing or by email giving a brief description of what is required, who is to be helped and why it thought that the Foundation should help. They should be sent to the address below and the Trustees will consider the merits of the application at their next meeting following which the applicant will be notified of their decision. The Trustees only meet quarterly so an early advance application is very helpful as there may be several weeks wait for a decision.

We place an online obituary at www.lymn.co.uk/obituaries for every funeral we arrange unless instructed otherwise. The basic details are entered by us, followed by an email sent to a family member providing details on how to add more. Please be sure to check your junk email folder for this.

# Obituary

A Funeral Guide online obituary allows the client to commemorate their family member or friend with a full-page picture and biography, as well as giving easy access to practical details such as the location and time of the funeral service.

### Memorial Book

A Funeral Guide online memorial book is a dynamic resource for you to store memories about the person who has died. Inside the book, pictures can be displayed, stories collated and a full biography of the life created.

The memorial book is fully interactive meaning that friends and family can leave messages, light candles and post photos. As owner of the condolence book, our client, will have complete control over the messages that are displayed.

#### **Donations**

For online donations the obituary also allows family and friends to donate online easily and to Gift Aid via our partnership with Just Giving. This can be done via www.lymn.co.uk/obituaries

The family announcement in the newspaper should be closed "Family flowers only please", or "No flowers please but donations for [Chosen charity] may be sent to A.W. Lymn The Family Funeral Service or submitted online at www. lymn.co.uk/obituaries with gift aid where appropriate".

If a retiring collection is to be taken at church or at the cemetery or crematorium chapel, then the permission of the Minister or Authority must be sought.

All donations are recorded individually when a name and address is given.

For security all donations are banked in a "Client Donations Account" at Barclays Bank; this account is operated free of charge by the Bank and no interest is credited.

Any Donations sent online can be increased in line with the Gift Aid rules (subject to the charity being registered with Just Giving) by the click of a button, and if posted with a relevant declaration can be handled in the same way.

Approximately one month after the funeral, the donations list is closed and a cheque for the total amount forwarded to the charity together with details of the family and the deceased person, and a list of the individual names, and individual amounts donated. This acts as an independent check on the accuracy of our records, but will not include online donations.





Canopy *from £250.00* 

A small canopy is available to provide cover to the grave at the time of the burial. This canopy is black and is approximately 3m by 6m, it does not have sides so all mourners can see the coffin and the burial, but it does keep the rain off the grave, the coffin, and the main mourners.

Chairs from £100.00

We can supply locally 20 folding chairs which can be used at a graveside for main mourners. These can be used with either white or red covers and includes a bow.

Carpeting from £250.00

Red, Pink & Blue coloured carpeting can be provided around a grave, and this is normally done in conjunction with the canopy. The carpet would be used once to keep mud and dirt away from the graveside if the ground conditions are particularly bad. We also have red, pink & blue ropes available.

# Automatic Lowering Device from £250.00

When required we can supply an automatic lowering device. This is the type often used in America for lowering large caskets into a grave at a slow and steady pace. This device is included in the price for certain of our Prestige American Caskets (page 54) where feasible, practical and permitted.



The above does not apply in the case of burial.

We will pass them on to Shoe Aid and The Friary which are both local Nottingham based charities.

### Clothes & Furniture

Sue Ryder is a national healthcare charity, delivering care in local communities through a network of hospices and specialist care centres across the UK. Their services include long term, palliative, respite and end of life care for people living with progressive conditions such as cancer, multiple sclerosis, Huntington's disease, Parkinson's disease, motor neurone disease, stroke or brain injury and HIV. Any donation will help Sue Ryder care for people living through the challenges of life changing illness.

We can also arrange to collect good quality furniture free of charge and work locally with Age Concern, Carlton & District.

# Jewellery

Since then they have continued to increase the ways in which they support existing services whilst developing new solutions to help amputees. In countries that are more fortunate they've learnt that there is a significant wastage of valuable material, components and resources that can make huge changes in less fortunate parts of the world. They support the empowerment of amputees across Africa so that they may dispel current stigmas by proving that disability does not equate to inability. If you have a prosthetic to donate your local office will arrange this for you.

# The Bereavement Register

The Bereavement Register was launched as a service for members of the general public and is specifically designed to remove from databases and mailing lists the names and addresses of those who have died. We are often bombarded with unsolicited mail or post we just don't want and unfortunately this does not stop when we die.

By registering with The Bereavement Register, the amount of direct mail sent to the deceased person will reduce within four to six weeks, leading to virtually nothing within six months. Should you continue to receive items of direct mail, you can forward all items to their Freepost address and they will contact the companies concerned directly on your behalf.

All Clients of A.W. Lymn The Family Funeral Service will automatically have their details recorded with The Bereavement Register unless they specifically request not to.

# Nottinghamshire Police Force Scam Warning

### Fraud advice for the recently bereaved.

In 2020 we were contacted by Nottinghamshire Police to help stop funeral fraudsters scamming bereaved families in the East Midlands. Scammers are convincing liars who will stop at nothing to make sure their scams seem plausible and unfortunately research has shown that recently bereaved people are more susceptible.

Never respond to phone calls, e-mails or letters which may come out of the blue without talking to friends or relatives first. You can also call or drop into any of our funeral home to ask for advice.

### Remember to:

### STOP • THINK • GET ADVICE.

Some scams to be aware of:-

### Romance fraud

Romance fraud is a confidence trick where a criminal establishes a fake online presence to gain the victim's love and trust. The fraudster then uses this romantic, personal connection to manipulate and exploit the victim into giving them money. Declarations of love may come within a matter of weeks, days or hours and may cloud the victim's judgement.

### What to do:

- Never give away personal details, including your age and birth date
- Watch out for odd spellings and grammar
- Profile location if the location states they are in Malaysia but their profile states they are looking for a relationship in Germany - beware
- Do not share pictures or information about yourself that can give someone a hold over you
- Speak openly about your dating with trusted friends and family. Alert them if the contact starts to feel strange. If their advice is to back off, LISTEN! They can provide the correct level of judgement with your best interests at heart
- Stop communicating if pressured

### Investment scam

This could involve a call from someone who says they run an investment scheme or are a stockbroker, they may put the victim under pressure to send money immediately, saying the offer is only available for a short time and stating that there is little or no risk.

### What to do:

- Hang up
- · Never invest money without doing your own research
- Don't give in to pressure
- Tell your bank and the police

### Courier & general phone scams

A cold call from a company or person you have never dealt with before or when a call is received saying they are from the victim's bank or the police. They may say someone has been fraudulently using the victim's bank account and will either send a courier to collect the bank card or ask the victim to buy an expensive item of jewellery to give to a courier or ask for a money transfer online.

### What to do:

- Hang up and call your bank and the police
- Don't give in to pressure
- Contact your provider and make sure your number is ex-directory
- Register with the Telephone Preference Service
- Invest in a call blocker
- Contact your local council and get your details removed from the OPEN Electoral Register this will stop your details being publically available
- Remove your details from 192.com

### What to do if you've been scammed

If you have been scammed, don't feel embarrassed about reporting it - fraudsters are clever and it can happen to anyone. By reporting the crime, it can prevent it from happening to others.

### Contact the police immediately on 101 if:

- The scammer is in your area
- You've transferred money to the scammer in the last 24 hours
- If you feel threatened or unsafe, call 999




